



52nd International Mirror Class Australian Championship Sailing Summary 28th December 2017

Day 2 started off with a big southerly coming in at about 35 knots, resulting in the PRO David Graney holding the boats on shore for about half an hour while the breeze settled.

Racing got underway in about 15 knots and the southerly became a sou-easterly but with some significant waves making for good surfing off the wind.

Four races were completed with South Australian and New South Wales boats dominating the podium.

Race 2 saw local boat *Sky 3* sailed by Marcus McKay and Rose Landon finish in 4th spot, but unfortunately they suffered gear failure later in the day when in 2nd place. After four races, *Bob* sailed by current Australian Champion Damian Carey with Lauren Armstrong, is in first place, followed by *Waterborne at Last*, Douglas Raftesath and Spencer McKay (New South Wales) and *Wavecatcher* (Campbell and Stirling McKay) in third.
